The Town

Our London course is based at the University of Greenwich, in the residential suburb of Eltham, in the south-east of London. The city of London is, of course, one of the world's leading attractions, full of sight-seeing opportunities, bars, restaurants, an enormously diverse range of entertainment and superb shopping facilities.

The Course Centre

The campus is set in a beautiful environmentally-protected parkland within easy reach of Central London (just a half-hour train or coach journey).

Activities

Full-day excursions include places of interest such as Oxford, London and Portsmouth, with half-day visits to "The Tate Modern" (Britain's new national museum of modern art), and fairytale Leeds Castle, with its maze and grotto. Students can dance away their excess energy at the twice-weekly disco and there are activities planned every afternoon, evening and weekend.

Accommodation

Residential students are housed in a modern student village in small 4 and 5 bedroom flats or 6 and 7 bedroom maisonettes. Each single study bedroom has its own individual washing facilities and fridge, and students share the bathroom (with shower). Meals are taken in the modern self-service refectory although each flat or maisonette has its own fully-fitted kitchen where students can prepare drinks and snacks. There are laundry facilities located centrally within the campus and each student flat has an iron and ironing board.

HOW TO GET TO GREENWICH

From Heathrow

By Underground to Charing Cross. By train from Charing Cross to Eltham, trains go twice an hour. (25 mins)

From Gatwick

By train from Gatwick to London Bridge (every half hour), from London Bridge to Eltham - trains leave twice an hour. Total travel time 1 hour.

From London Victoria / Waterloo (Eurostar)

By taxi or Underground to Victoria Coach/Train Station.

The coach service runs very frequently direct to Eltham. (35mins)

By taxi or Underground to Charing Cross, then by train to Eltham, trains go twice an hour. (25 mins)

USEFUL INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

There are telephones for the use of the students in the Student Village. As these are public telephone boxes, parents are advised to tell their children approximately at what time they will be ringing, so that the students can be near the telephone to take the call. Alternatively it is suggested that students call home regularly rather than parents attempting the often difficult task of locating their children.

As there is one telephone box for every stairwell, we ask that on arrival, each student calls home to inform his or her family of the telephone number of the nearest box.

Please telephone only before 08.30 hrs and between 20.00 hrs and 22.30 hrs. (English time). We would request you NOT to telephone outside the above hours, as students will NOT be there and cannot be contacted except during the time stated.

A great deal of thought has gone into arranging these stays, so you may be sure that the students will be looked after with great care. We should like to draw your attention to the following points:

In addition to the normal clothing you expect to provide for the stay, please also include the following: swimming towels (hand towels are provided), swimming costume, a few items of warm clothing, raincoat, sports clothes and shoes.

Please note that students must bring white-soled gym shoes. Outdoor shoes will not be allowed in the gymnasium.

Sports facilities available on campus are tennis courts, squash courts, football and cricket pitches and a gymnasium.

Students interested in tennis should bring a tennis racquet.

Laundry facilities are located centrally within the college and each student flat has an ironing board. The cost of a token for the washing machine is £1.20 and that for a dryer token is £0.20.

Please make sure that the student's name is marked on all clothes and other belongings.

A deposit of approximately £25.00 is required from all students on arrival, payable to the Course Director, to cover accidental loss of keys. The deposit is fully refundable at the end of the stay when the keys are returned to the Course Director.
